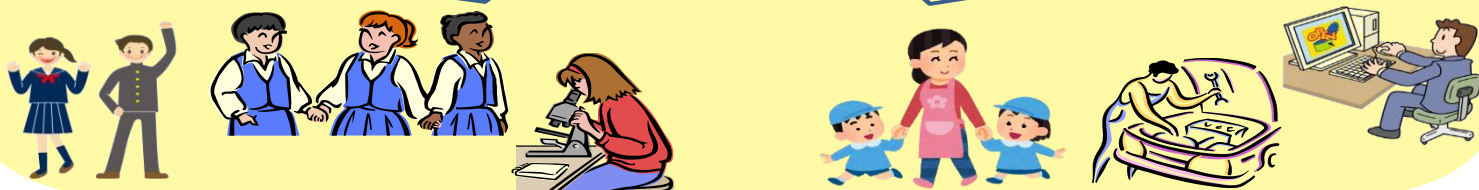

How to register for the seminar



There are two ways to participate: by attending in person at the venue, or by participating online.

1. How to participate by coming to the venue :

- (2) We will be using ZOOM, so please install ZOOM on your smartphone/tablet/PC beforehand.

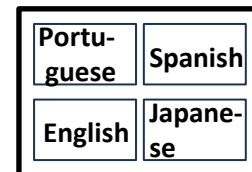
